A select group of the best and the brightest will receive a **full in-state tuition, four-year renewable scholarship** at Indiana State University.

The Networks Financial Institute (NFI) was created through a generous grant from the Lilly Endowment, Inc. Networks Scholarships are available to students majoring in business with the intention to pursue careers in the financial services industry. Examples include: Financial planning, sales, marketing, financial analysis, insurance and risk management, operations management, accounting, and information systems.

To be eligible to apply, students must be admitted as an incoming freshman to Indiana State by December 1, 2016. Qualified students should possess two of the following three criteria:

1. A cumulative GPA of at least 3.50 on a 4.0 scale
2. A 1070 SAT (combined critical reading and math) or 1140 SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math) or 23 ACT
3. Ranking in the top 15% of the senior class

Please note that a student must have applied to Indiana State by December 1, 2016 to access the Networks Scholarship application. Completed applications, including all required materials, are **due by December 15, 2016**.
