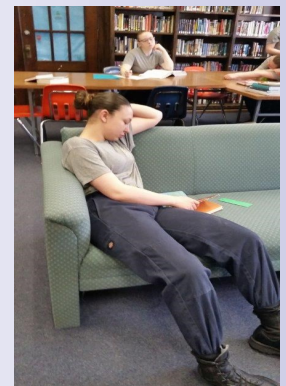


WEEK 14
